SECURITY BULLETIN

SUBJECT: Displaying MAC-Issued Identification Badge

Per MAC Ordinance, authorized persons shall display their valid MAC-Issued Identification Badge whenever they are within the Airport Security Areas by displaying the Identification Badge on the person's outermost garment above the waist with the photograph side showing for public view.

This means that your badge must be displayed on the Air Operations Area (AOA), in the tug drive, etc. even when you are actively working.

To avoid violation, utilize the proper badge holder that will best fit your needs: lanyard, arm-band, clip, retractable clip, safety vest with badge holder, etc.

Reminder: Although a good practice, it is not a requirement to display your badge in the sterile area of the terminals.



ADDITIONAL SECURITY INFORMATION

- Access at the un-staffed field gates continues to be reduced. Please utilize staffed field gates such as Gate 101, Gate 113, and Gate 222 to access the Air Operations Area.
- Gate 113 will close permanently within the next year due to Glumack Drive rerouting. Please utilize Gate 101 when the gate is closed.
